Dear Chief Larry Hall:

I am a concerned citizen who has an interest in the case of Daniel Cornelius Robinson, who went missing in Maricopa County in the Sonoran Desert in Buckeye, AZ. I understand that your department took Daniel's case on June 23, 2021, when his father put in a missing person's report after attempting to do so with the Tempe Police Department.

Daniel's case has been open in your department for almost two years without any promising results of gaining information that will lead to his being found. Daniel's father has been chief in the efforts to find his son. He has conducted over forty-eight weeks of desert searches, put out thousands of flyers across the country, followed, cleared, and gained leads that may result in understanding what happened. In addition, Mr. Robinson has been doing an investigation that resulted in finds that he shared with your department information and hard-physical evidence of possible foul play. Mr. Robinson expressed that he lost confidence in your department for various reasons and has requested a change in jurisdiction.

I ask that you please not hold Mr. Robinson's son's case hostage and to please allow the FBI or the Maricopa Sheriff's Office to take complete jurisdiction and control of this case. It would be in the interests and requests of my family, the public, and me. I ask that you release everything to the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office so they can open an independent investigation into his son's disappearance. Please give these agencies the needed information and any evidence collected that would help them locate Daniel. Mr. Robinson's son went missing in Maricopa County, and the county takes some Jurisdictional responsibilities. I believe that a change in jurisdiction creates an atmosphere that allows Law enforcement and Mr. Robinson to work together to find his son. This case has been going on for two years without answers from your department. A fresh set of eyes may bring Daniel back home to his family. It is not about your department but about bringing Daniel back home to his family.
